Kia Ora Whanau,

...as far as we know ... We are moving to L2 on Sunday at midnight. That will mean all schools will be open on Monday the 31st and we will be at L2.

This L2 opening will look almost the same as the last L2 opening. Except that:

- 1. Please, when you are dropping your child at school or picking them up from school that <u>you</u> wear a mask. It sends a good message to your children and to the community that we are very keen to stop the spread of the virus.
- 2. If you wish for your child to wear a face mask please ensure they know how to wear one and that they have one and a spare one should they need it. The school will not be supplying face masks. Please make sure your child's face mask is named. I encourage you to get personal masks if you wish your child to have one(Instead of constantly using only single use masks. These can be made very cheaply and help save the planet). Here is a link to a very easy, and simple, and cheap... way to make masks while you are at home. - 3. To limit the possibility of contagion in the school we are asking you to drop and pick-up at the gates.
- 4. No adults in the grounds please. The gates will be locked at 9am and up until children are returned to their parents at just before 3:00pm
- 5. Please give your child a reusable bottle of water to drink at school. Taps will be shut off while in L2.

We look forward to seeing all our students back at school on Monday 31 August. They will be safe. We will do all in our power to ensure they are safe. We look forward to hearing about their experiences and to shepherding your children through this transition calmly and safely.



Please be kind to each other over this next few days and we look forward to seeing you all and your children all being back at Fruitvale on the 31st of August.
